

New Campaign Launched to Combat Opioid Abuse

Rhode Island has launched a new website, help line and expanded its public awareness campaign to combat opioid abuse. Governor Gina Raimondo made the announcement at the Brown University School of Public Health. The website, <http://preventoverdoseri.org>, provides information about where to find help in Rhode Island. The phone help line, 401-942-STOP, connects people to treatment and recovery services between 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. each day.
